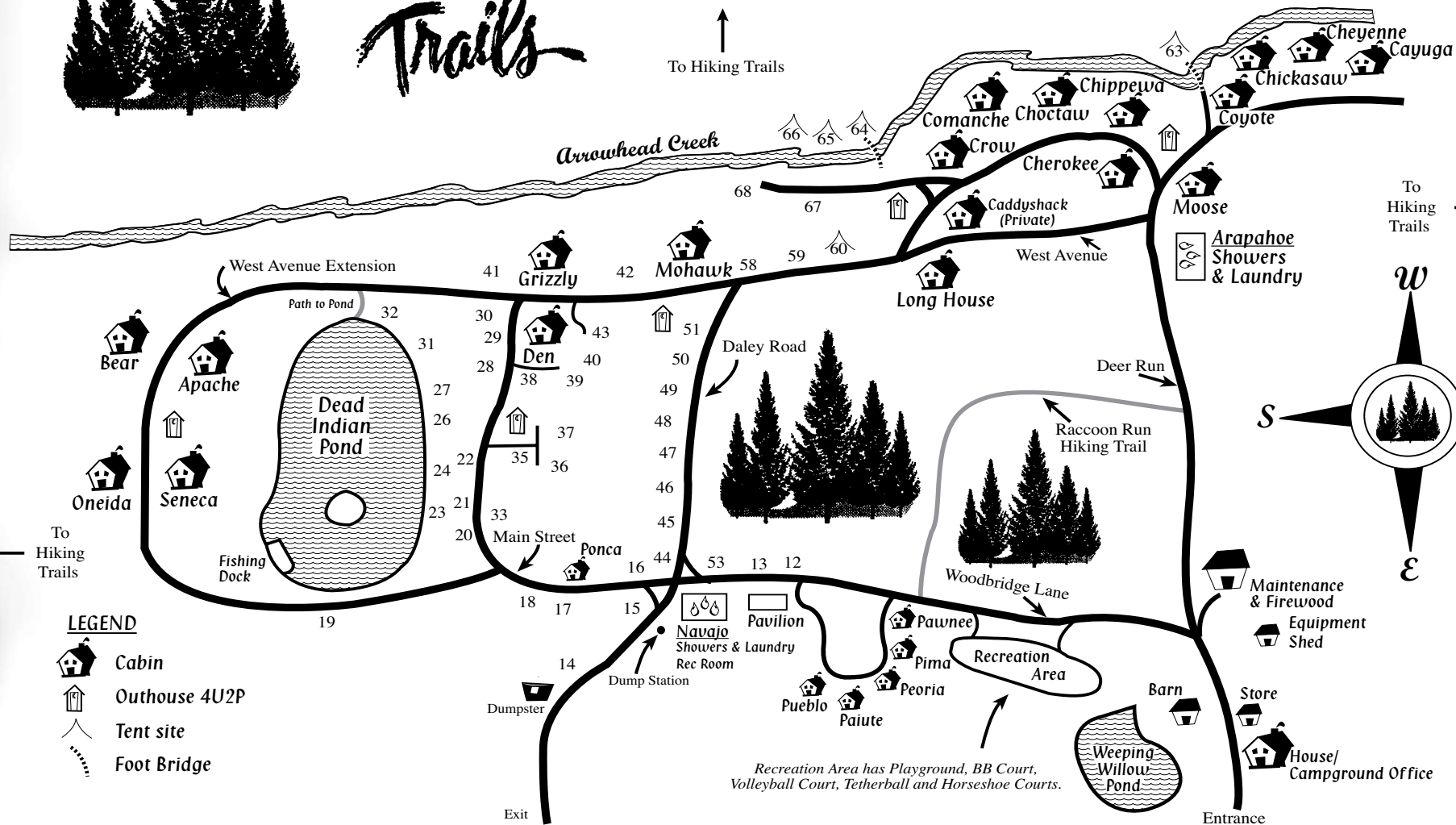




EVERGREEN Trails

CAMPGROUND RULES & REGULATIONS

CAMPFIRES

Permitted only in designated fire rings. No fires are to be pyramided or have flames more than 2 feet high. All fires must be extinguished before leaving or retiring for the evening. No chainsaws permitted. Do not break or cut any trees, limbs or bushes. Firewood is available at the camp store.

CARS

Speed limit is 5 mph. Please do not block the roads. No mini-bikes or any other unauthorized motorized vehicle. Maximum number of cars per cabin or site is two (2); all others are to park in overflow area.

FIREARMS / FIREWORKS

No BB, pellet guns or other firearms are permitted. Absolutely no fireworks—they are illegal and a danger to the user and the campground.

FISHING

Allowed in both ponds. We have a “catch and release” program—please return all fish, unharmed, to the water immediately. Pick up all poles, hooks, bait cans, and trash when leaving.

PETS

Are allowed in the cabins but not in the bathhouses. They must be kept on a leash and should never be left unattended. You are responsible for droppings anywhere in the campground—please pick up ASAP. Owners and their threatening or excessively barking dogs will be asked to leave.

QUIET HOURS

10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. No noise shall leave your campsite. Children must be at site. Please be considerate of your fellow campers

VISITORS

All visitors must register at the office. There is a \$5.00 per day fee for each visiting vehicle. Maximum of one (1) guest vehicle per cabin or campsite unless prior arrangements are made. No visitors allowed after 9:00 p.m.

WATER

Faucets are to be used for filling vessels only—do not leave open for long periods of time. No washing of dishes or vehicles at faucet.

Campground management reserves the right to evict any person who fails to observe the campground rules & regulations or creates a disturbance of any kind.

HELPFUL INFORMATION

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT

Check-in time is 2:00 p.m.

Check-out time is 11:00 a.m. — especially for cabins.

SHOWERS/LAUNDRY

Located at Navajo and Arapahoe—50 cents (2 quarters) for 5 minutes of hot shower water. Please leave area in clean condition for your fellow campers. Coin-operated washers and dryers also available at each facility. Quarters are available at the campground office.

STORE/GIFT SHOP

Ice, firewood, ice cream, candy and other notions such as paper plates, napkins, and bug spray. There is also a gift shop with tee-shirts, sweatshirts, coffee mugs and other novelty items for both children and adults.

TRASH

A dumpster is available at the exit—please recycle; containers for tin cans, glass and plastic are provided. All other garbage must be placed in clear or white plastic bags.
